


Nottingham Trent Students' Union (NTSU) is an independent, charity organisation that aims to make your time at Trent the best it can be.

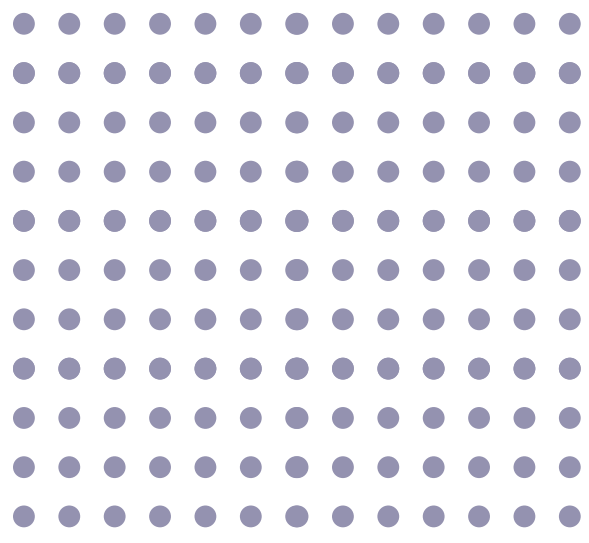
What we do

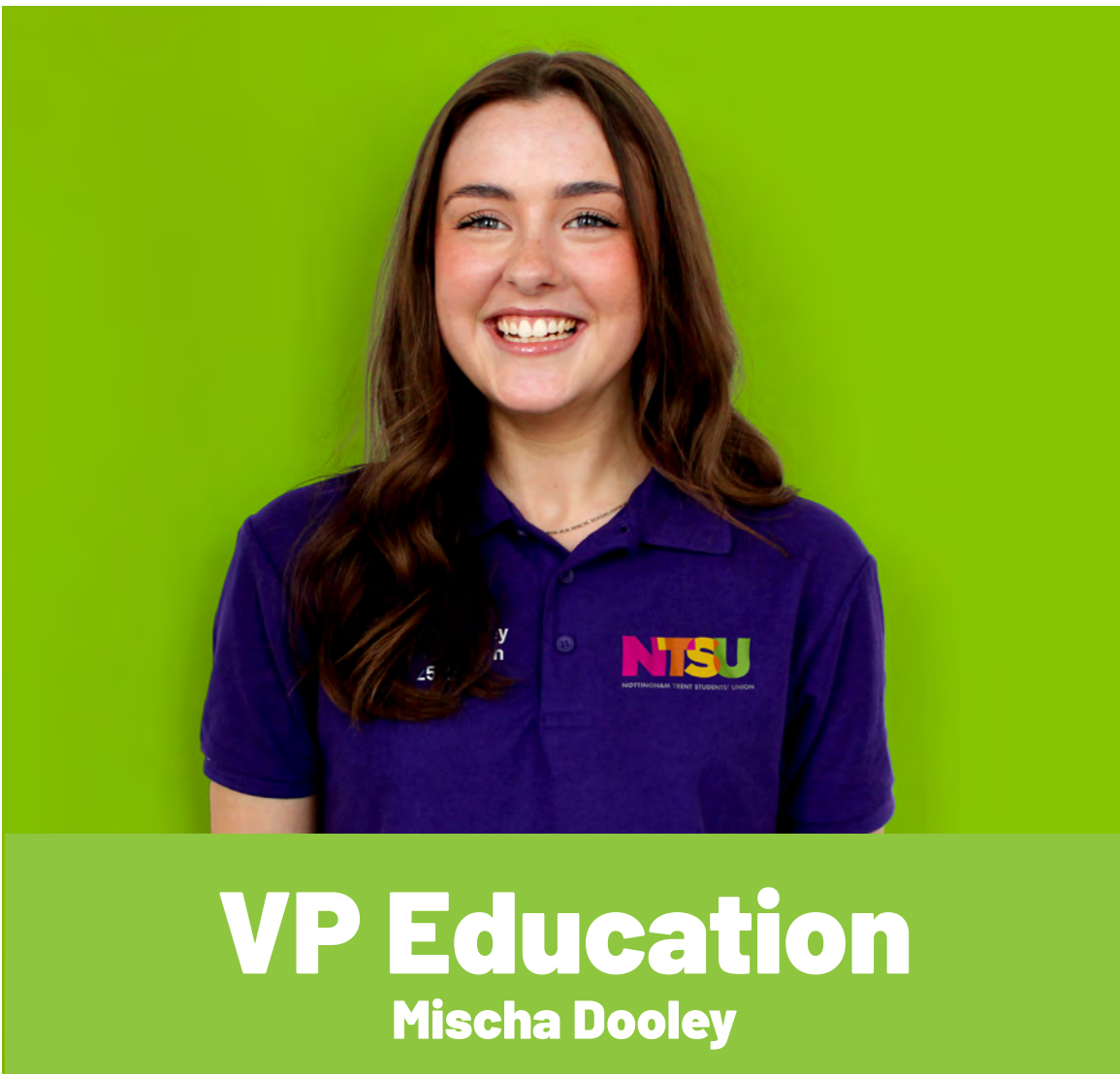

Hi I'm Ryan and I represent the views of postgrad / international students, making sure the Students' Union represents them in the best way possible.

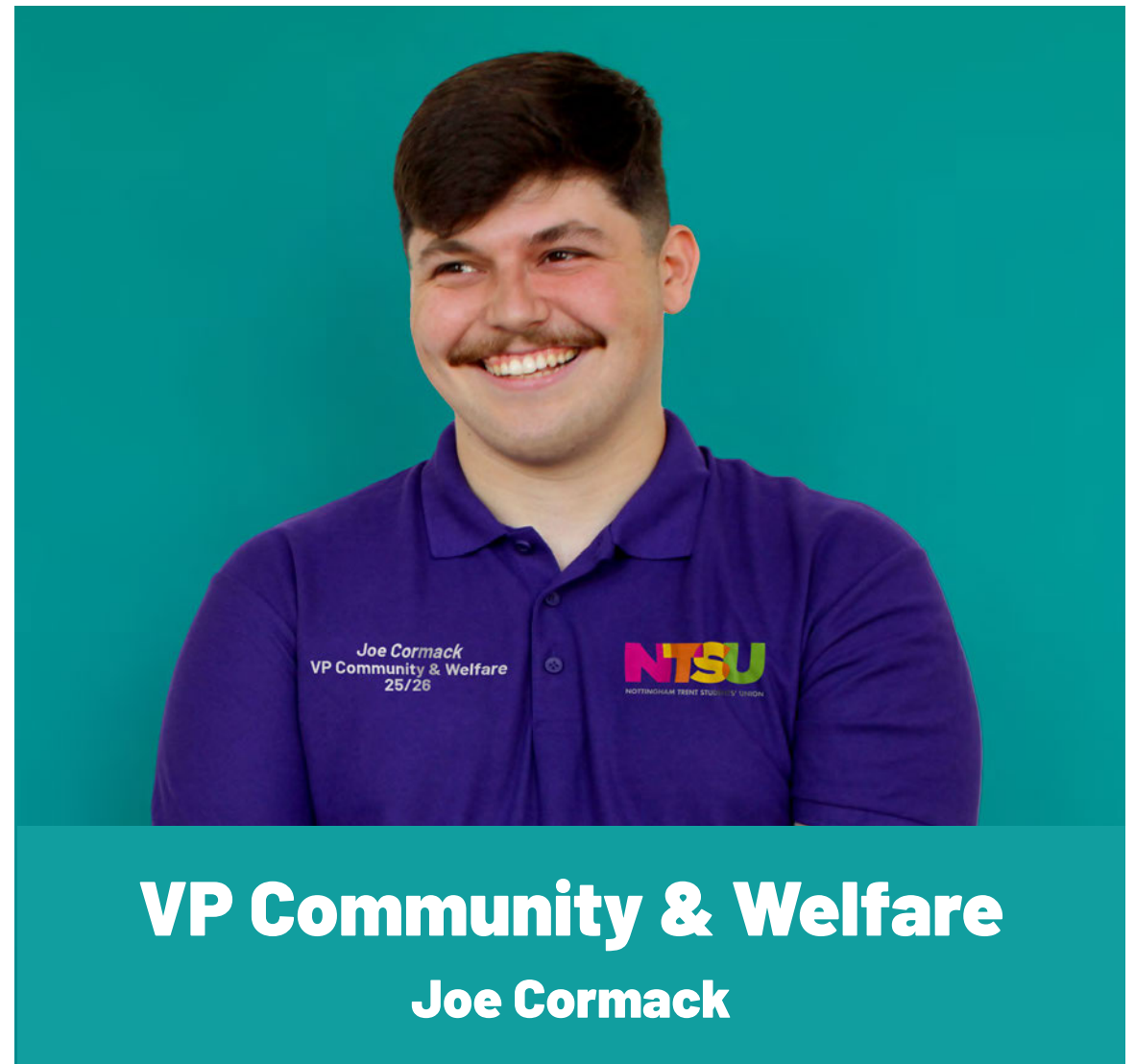

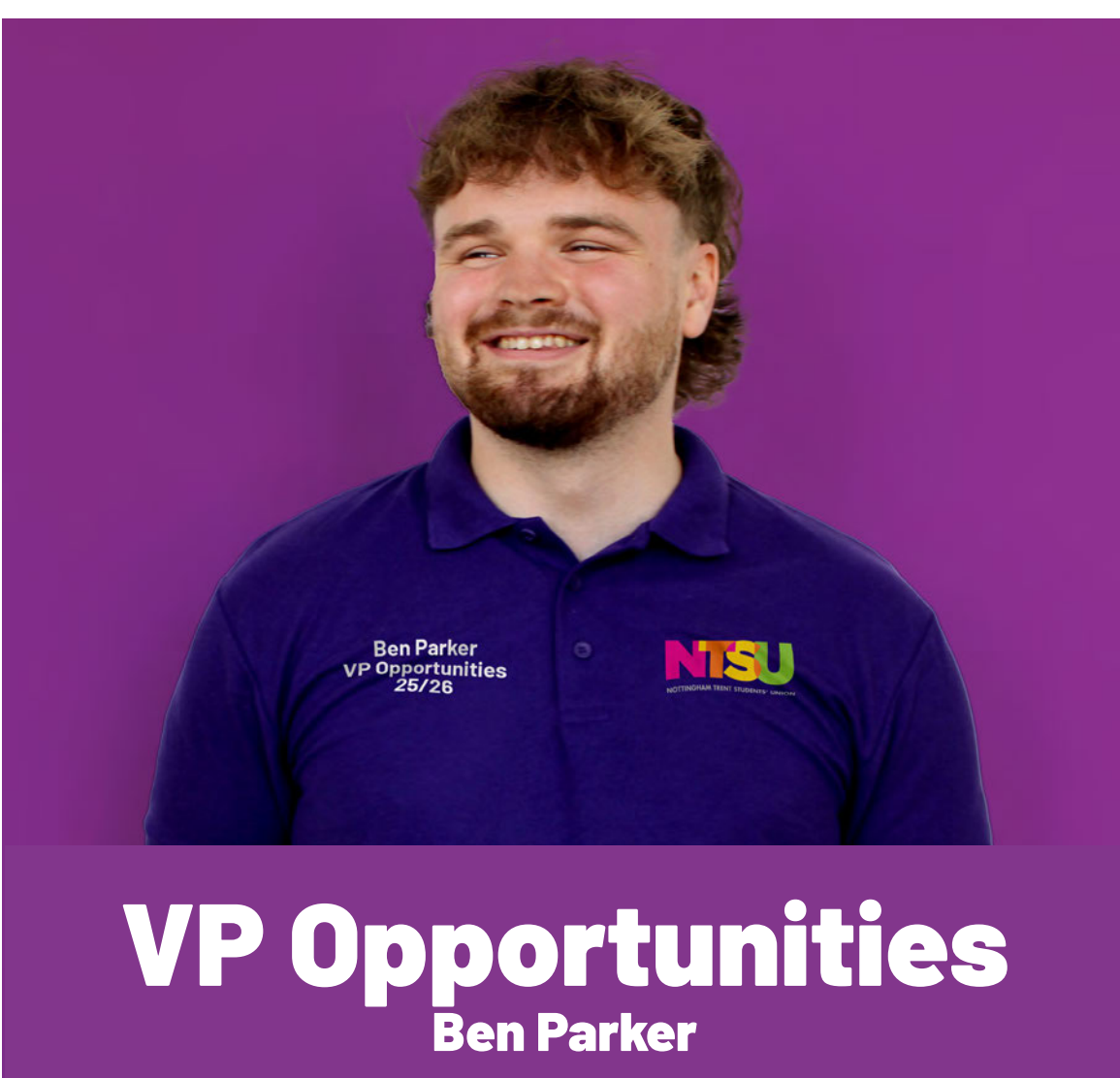
Hi I'm Mischa and I'm here to represent NTU students regarding their learning experience and help implement important changes to your education.

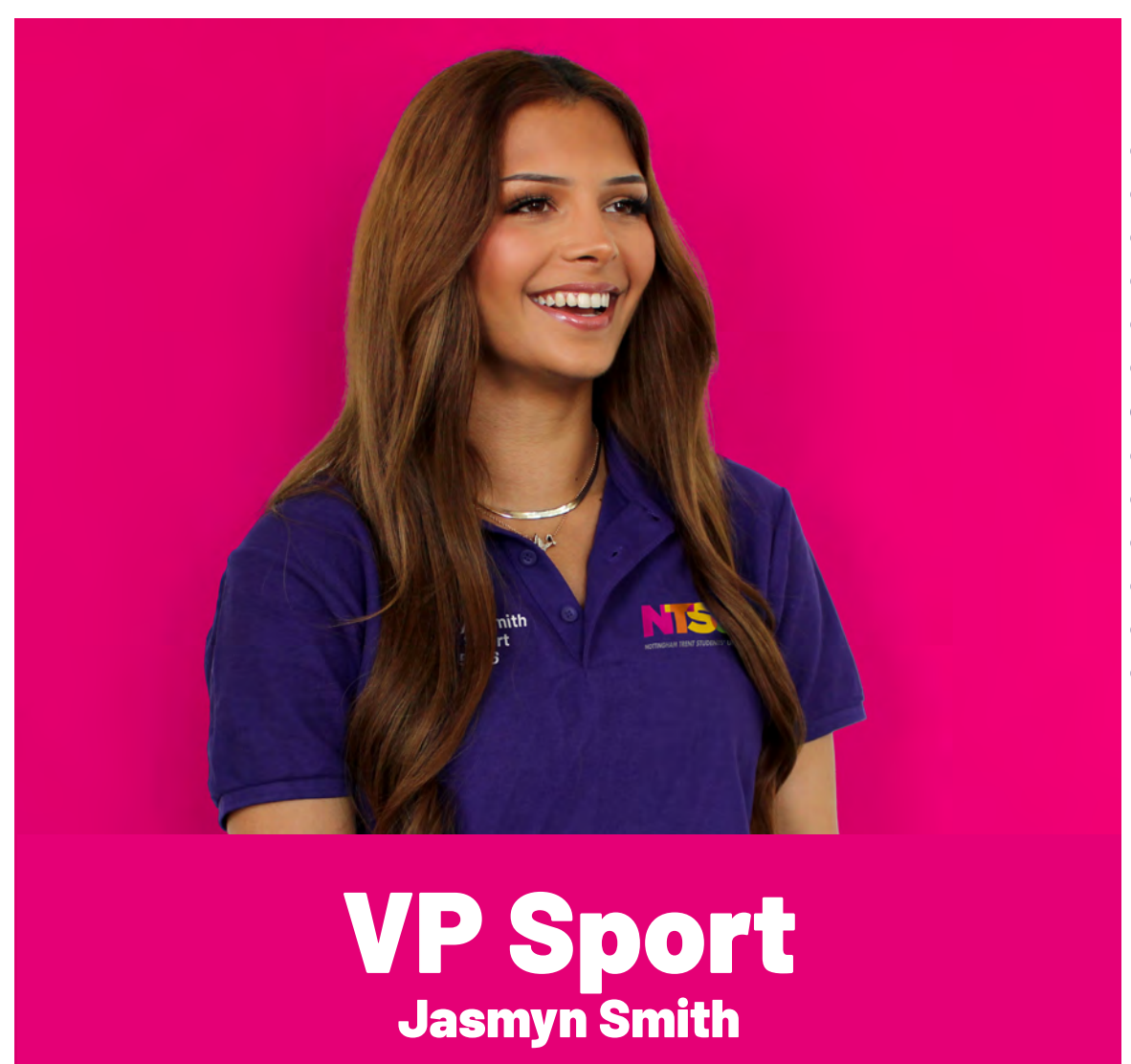

Plus, the experience is invaluable!

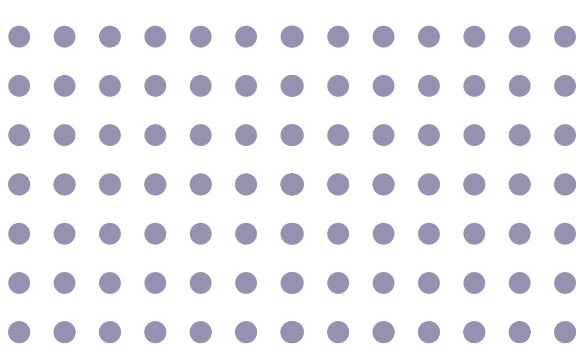

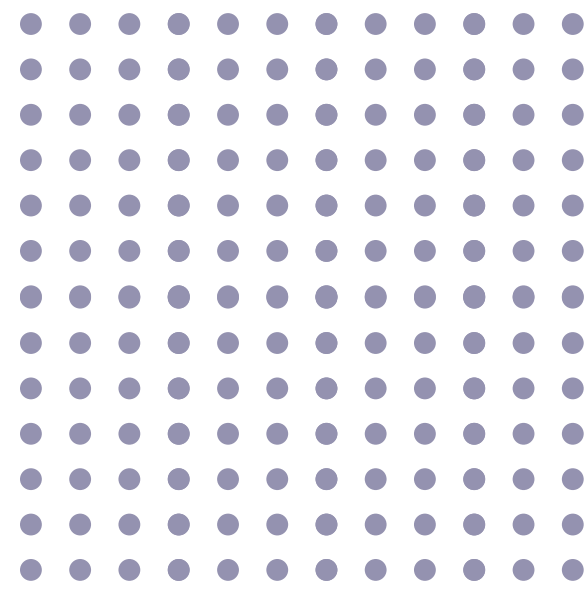

Safe Space

Campus SOS Points

Reports can either be made anonymously or by providing contact details, for yourself or for someone else.

Emergency Taxi Scheme

It's the end of the night, you've run out of money, don't have your bank card with you, and need to get a taxi home. What can you do?

1. Call Nottingham Cars on 01159 700 700 to book a taxi, stating you need to use the Student Emergency Taxi Scheme.
2. The taxi driver will take note of your NTU ID number so make sure you know this/ have it to hand in the taxi.
3. Your fare will temporarily be covered by NTSU, who will contact you to pay them back the next day - you will have one week to settle your bill.

Tips & Tricks

Sign up to your GP

Don't wait until you start to feel ill, or you have run out of your prescription, to register with your local GP.

The University practice helps with a range of services, such as sexual health and advice, to travel advice and immunisation. There is a local GP at all campuses.

HC2 Certificate

You may be eligible to receive help towards health costs, for example visits to the dentists or the opticians. Check your eligibility (it's worth applying to - worst they could do is say no!)

Printing via Email

Don't know which printer is which? Simply send your document to printmono@ntu.ac.uk, take your student card up to the nearest (mono or colour) printer, and print. Simple.
